January 11th– January 24th - please pray for our work in KENYA

- Please pray for our work serving traumatised children in the brutal slums of Nairobi, Kenya. In particular, for our partnerships with several churches and schools, who refer some of the toughest cases to us, as we train them in trauma awareness and how to work with traumatised children.
- Please also pray that our petition to stop child marriage amongst a community of Maasai (that has settled close to Nairobi), will be a success and that it will help our team to approach the authorities in February/March and raise the profile of these precious young women.
- Please also pray for the children and staff at our amazing Hall Mead School located in an incredibly fragile rural region, with high levels of child labour in the nearby quarries.
- We would value prayer for the many traumatised children who attend the school, that they will know God's healing through our specialist therapy team.
- We would especially welcome your prayers that we are able to raise funds for a new school bus, as the current drivers are having to start their daily rounds at 5:30am! A new larger bus will help spread the load.
- And for our relatively new 'Karundas Hope Centre' project located right next to Hall Mead, which serves some incredibly vulnerable children and their families. Please pray especially for the 70 or so mums and children who attend our 'mentorship programme' every Saturday morning.
- Please pray that the project will also be able to establish some excellent partnerships with local churches and schools.

Kids Alive Prayer Guide for Winter 2026



January 25th – February 7th - please pray for our work in HAITI

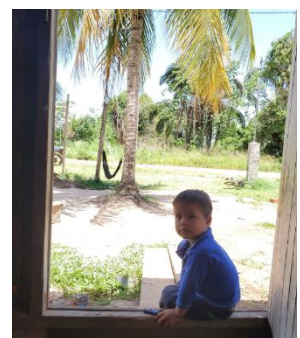
- Please pray for this violent and turbulent country, which is soaked in a culture of voodoo and black magic. That it can truly be transformed in Christ – spiritually, politically, socially and economically.
- That the many armed gangs there repent and lay down their weapons.
- That many displaced families can safely return to their homes, especially to the capital, Port au Prince. This includes the 50 or so we are currently serving.
- Pray for our staff as they launched the new school year in early January with 37 new students enrolling, including 22 from internally displaced families.
- Continued prayers for the many vulnerable children in Haiti, especially deportees from the Dominican Republic who have been forcibly removed, many of whom are children, including victims of abuse.
- Continued prayers for God to provide Kids Alive Haiti with the necessary resources—financial, material, and spiritual—to meet the physical, emotional, and educational needs of the 400 or so children we serve, as well as their families and communities.

February 8th – February 21st - please pray for our work in PERU

- Please thank God for the amazing progress our team has made in working with the authorities to help deal with the massive issue of physical and sexual violence against children (and women) in Peru.
- Please pray that we can complete a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Peru's Forensic Office, so we can help with more child-friendly video testimony rooms in the areas where we work. This in turn will result in more successful prosecutions against perpetrators of violence against children.
- Please also pray for the traumatised children and our staff at our two residential programmes in Peru (the authorities keep referring some incredibly difficult cases to us).
- Please pray for our 'Andahuaylas' project in a remote region of the Andes, where violence against children and women is especially bad (45% of women are victims of domestic abuse). That our project will have an incredible impact on this remote but populous region.

February 22nd – March 7th - please pray for our work in GUATEMALA

- Please pray for our work with traumatised girls who have suffered unspeakable sexual assault, some as young as five years old, many of whom are referred to us by the courts.
- For healing and restoration for the girls and anointing for our staff as they work with them.
- Continued prayers for Escuintla Justice Centre Team, seeking convictions of perpetrators of sexual violence against children, and of course, for the children themselves and their families.
- Please thank God that we have been awarded a grant to support the creation of seven trauma-informed, child-friendly court facilities throughout Guatemala. The grant will fund the remodelling of Peace, Juvenile, and Femicide Courts to create safe, welcoming environments where children and families can participate in legal processes with dignity and protection.
- And finally, for our staff working in particularly challenging and heartbreaking contexts, especially for the safety of those who pursue justice and are at risk of revenge attacks.

- And that we would become even more effective in our work in trauma care, especially at our Kids Alive Academy School in a fragile rural region in Western Province.

Kids Alive Prayer Guide for Winter 2026



March 22nd – April 4th - please pray for our work in LEBANON

- Please pray for our Country Director, Denise, and her incredible team, as they share the love of God with so many vulnerable Syrian refugees, in both word and deed.
- For the 250 or so children in Lebanon who attend our school in Beirut and our New Horizons Centre in the south. And more recently, with some incredibly traumatised and vulnerable children whose parents are in prison and there is no one else to care for them.
- Also for the 125 or so mums and older siblings in our 'Lighthouse Project'. About 70 of these regularly attend our twice-weekly Bible classes, up from 40 a year ago. This project is going so well that we are struggling to keep up with demand!
- In particular, please pray for our 'Couples Nights' and outreach work with the dads, many wary of all things Christian.
- Finally, please pray for the general situation in this troubled land, for safety and peace as tension and uncertainty continue.

April 5th – April 18th - please pray for our work in the DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

1. An important update about our work in the DR

- After 30 years of partnership and being part of the Kids Alive family, our team in the Dominican Republic has chosen to transition into their own independent organisation, ie away from Kids Alive.
- In recent years, KAI globally has increasingly focused on God's call to transform the lives of abused children, their families, and their communities through Gospel-centred trauma recovery, family strengthening, community transformation, and justice initiatives. Meanwhile, the DR ministries have remained deeply committed to God's calling for them and the mission of transforming lives through holistic Christian education, residential care, healthcare, and discipleship programmes.
- Recognising that serving two distinct missions under one organisation presents significant challenges, the DR leadership has chosen to form their own organisation, and Kids Alive International has agreed to support this transition.
- We believe both organisations can serve vulnerable children more effectively by focusing resources and messaging around our respective core strengths.
- So by the end of June 2026 at the latest, our work in the DR will be handed over to the team there and we will no longer be supporting them.



2. Please pray

- Pray for wisdom and clarity for both teams during this transition.
- For all of the 2,000 kids or so we serve there and their families connected to the DR programmes.
- That they - and the ministry itself - will not be impacted in any meaningful way.
