**May 3<sup>rd</sup> – May 16<sup>th</sup> - please pray for our work in LEBANON**

- Please pray for peace in this troubled country, so that it can start to heal and prosper again.
- Pray especially for our staff - for their motivation and morale as they continue to serve in such unsettling times. That they will be a shining light for Jesus in the only Arab country where the Gospel can be legally shared.
- Please continue to pray for our work with vulnerable Syrian refugee families, many re-traumatised by ongoing conflict and war.
- For continued blessing on our 'Lighthouse' ministry with the mums, over 90 of whom now come regularly to our Bible classes. And for our 'Couples Nights', which have been so effective in reaching out to the dads.
- And our relatively new ministry serving several children referred to us by the judicial system, all heart-breaking cases.
- Pray especially for our 'New Horizons' project in the south, serving teenage Syrian refugee girls and a group of impoverished Dom gypsies. They are at the centre of the conflict with Israel and are all especially vulnerable.
- For wisdom, guidance and protection for our Country Director, Denise Dagher, as she leads the team in very difficult circumstances.

**May 17<sup>th</sup> – May 30<sup>th</sup> - please pray for our work in KENYA**

- Please pray for our work serving traumatised children from the brutal slums in and around Nairobi. That they will know God’s love and healing as we work with partner churches and schools to reach them.
- Please also pray for our work with a community of Maasai, especially the 100 or so child brides and teen mums. Pray that God will anoint our staff as they advocate for reform in this community, including child marriage and FGM. Thank you to all of our supporters for signing our petition to help empower them to do this.
- Please also pray for the children and staff at our amazing Hall Mead School located in an incredibly fragile rural region, with high levels of child labour and suicide rates. Pray especially for resources, including a new school bus and classroom materials.
- We would value prayer for the many traumatised children who attend the school, that they will know God’s healing through our specialist therapy team.
- And for our relatively new ‘Karundas Hope Centre’ project located right next to Hall Mead, which serves some incredibly vulnerable children and their families.
- Finally, we would also welcome your prayers that our team are able to establish ways to pursue justice, especially for child victims of sexual abuse.

**May 31<sup>st</sup> – June 13<sup>th</sup> - please pray for our work in HAITI**

- Please pray for this violent and turbulent country, which is soaked in a culture of voodoo and black magic. That it can truly be transformed in Christ – spiritually, politically, socially and economically.
- In particular, for our wonderful school that serves about 300 of Haiti’s most impoverished and vulnerable children, including 50 or so from displaced families who have had to flee the capital city, Port au Prince, due to gang violence.

- For resources for the school and funds to employ an additional psychologist and social worker.
- Continued prayers for the vulnerable children, especially deportees from the Dominican Republic (many Haitian children), including victims of abuse, who have been forcibly returned.
- Continued prayers for provision of resources - financial, material, and spiritual - to meet their physical, emotional, and educational needs.
- Continued prayers for Haiti's restoration - political, social, economic, and above all, spiritual. That the many armed gangs repent and lay down their weapons and the many displaced families safely return to their homes.
- God's justice, mercy, and healing over Haiti.

## June 14<sup>th</sup> – June 27<sup>th</sup> - please pray for our work in PERU

- Please thank God for the amazing progress our team has made in working with the authorities to help deal with the massive issue of physical and sexual violence against children (and women) in Peru.
- Please pray for the implementation of our new plans to address sexual violence against children by 2030. In particular, the resources and partnerships needed to reach more child victims of sexual assault, including those in the more remote regions.
- Specifically, reducing fear and anxiety during legal interviews and testimony, often using our 'Soy David' comic-strip workbook (this amazing resource uses the story of David vs Goliath to embolden and empower child victims of abuse to give evidence).
- For our work with vulnerable and abused children in the slums of Manchay; in the jungle region of Pucallpa; and in the beautiful but troubled Andahuaylas region of the Andes.

# Kids Alive Prayer Guide for Summer 2026



June 28<sup>th</sup> – July 11<sup>th</sup> please pray for our work in GUATEMALA

- Please pray for our work with traumatised girls who have suffered unspeakable sexual assault, some as young as five years old, many of whom are referred to us by the courts.
- For healing and restoration for the girls and anointing for our staff as they work with them.
- Please pray for the 40 or so girls staying at our Oasis Centre as they recover from the horrendous traumas they have been through. That they will all come to know God and His healing.
- And for the 20 or so young women at our Casa Ester programme, all of whom are too old to stay at Oasis, that they will be able to successfully integrate back into society after all they have been through.
- We are very excited about a recent agreement we have made with the Guatemala Supreme Court, who want us to train their judges in child-friendly justice processes, as well as proper trauma-informed care for victims. Please pray that this will be a great success and the start of a major change in how Guatemala handles child victims of sexual assault.
- Continued prayers for Escuintla Justice Centre Team, seeking convictions of perpetrators of sexual violence against children, and of course, for the children themselves and their families.
- And finally, please pray for continued anointing on our wonderful survivors' group called 'Comunidad de Aves', where girls and young women get together to encourage each other and develop friendships.

July 12<sup>th</sup> – July 25<sup>th</sup> - please pray for our work in ZAMBIA

- Please pray that we are able to serve some of Zambia's most vulnerable and traumatised children, referred to us by the authorities as there is nowhere else for them.
- Little ones who are told to wait on a street corner by their mum, only for her to run away and abandon them.
- For the babies and toddlers we serve who are raised in abject prison conditions. That they and their mums will come to know God, as we partner with local churches who come to visit them and minister to them.
- But the biggest area we would welcome your prayers is in our work advocating and caring for child victims of sexual abuse, which is incredibly widespread here, especially in rural areas.
- Give thanks that we have recently signed an agreement with Zambia's National Prosecution Authority, so we can work together to promote a child-friendly justice and care system. Would you please pray that this partnership will be truly transformational?
- Finally, could you please pray for our work at our primary school in the Western Province, one of Zambia's poorest regions? Please give thanks that despite only admitting the most vulnerable, we still had the best academic performance in the district in 2025.
- Please pray that we build on these successes, as well as introduce trauma training programmes for those children who have suffered particular trauma. And for our tailoring project to help provide training and livelihoods for some of the most fragile families.
- Please give thanks for our relationship with the Christian charity, Tools with a Mission, who provide free refurbished sewing machines and equipment to us.

# Kids Alive Prayer Guide for Summer 2026



**July 26<sup>th</sup> – August 8<sup>th</sup> - please pray as we transition out of Dominican Republic**

- You may be aware that Kids Alive is a global partnership, working with affiliated but independent charities in various countries, eg Kids Alive Zambia and Kids Alive Lebanon.
- After thoughtful prayer, planning, and conversation, the Dominican Republic leadership team has chosen to transition into their own independent organisation. In other words, to move out of the Kids Alive family.
- In recent years, KAI has increasingly focused on God's call to transform the lives of abused children, their families, and their communities through Gospel-centred trauma recovery, family strengthening, community transformation, and justice initiatives. Meanwhile, the DR ministries have remained deeply committed to God's calling for them and the mission of transforming lives through holistic Christian education, residential care, healthcare, and discipleship programmes.
- Recognising that serving two distinct missions under one organisation presents significant challenges, the DR leadership has chosen to form their own organisation, and Kids Alive International has agreed to support this transition. We believe both organisations can serve vulnerable children more effectively by focusing resources and messaging around our respective core strengths.
- Please can you pray that this transition goes smoothly and that the ministry in Dominican Republic continues to thrive, especially its amazing work through seven schools in some incredibly tough regions?
- And for the continued goodwill and Godly way the respective leadership teams have handled the separation.

- In Zambia, please pray that our recent agreement with the prosecution authorities will bear tremendous fruit.
- And that a potential game-changing partnership in Kenya comes to fruition.
- Please also pray for our work around the world in trauma care, without which many of the children we serve (and their families and communities) will have emotional, social and behavioural issues for life. That God will continue to bless our teams wherever they work, as they serve some incredibly traumatised and vulnerable children.
